### 1. LEVELS AT VIN-TER LANGUAGE SCHOOL

The KID Program is offered at three levels: Initial Stage, Stage 1, and Stage 2.

### 2. PROGRAMS AND MODALITIES

At Vin-Ter, we have a wide range of scheduling and frequency for each program. This document is designed to help you understand the different modalities that Vin-Ter LS offers. See a breakdown for each program.

Kids (Initial Stage, Stage 1, Stage 2)	Regular program four times a week	1hr each class
Kids (Stage 1, Stage 2)	Weekend Programs Saturdays and Sundays	2hrs with a 10-min break in between.
Kids (Initial Stage, Stage 1, Stage 2)	Intensive program Three times a week	1hr 30 mins with a 5-min break in between.

Super Youth (SJ 1-6)	<b>Regular program</b> Four times a week	1h each class
Super Youth (SJ 1-6)	Weekend Programs Saturdays and Sundays	1h 30 mins with a 5-min break in between.
Super Youth (SJ 1-6)	Intensive program Three times a week	2hrs class with a 10-min break in between.

Regular Program	1 unit is completed in 4 weeks	16 hours
Regular Intensive Program	2 units is completed in 4 weeks	24 hours
Weekend Program	1 unit is completed in 8 weeks	24 hours
Kid Stage 1 and 2 Weekend Program	1 unit is completed in 8 weeks	32 hours

### 3. METHODOLOGY

At Vin-Ter Language School, your kid will be taught in a Total Immersion Learning Methodology provided by our highly well-trained and experienced Language Instructors and native of the target language. We will provide an access credential for your Kid's own-paced learning homework. Our independent learning digital platform will allow the student to have access to their level material and assignments given and monitored by their instructor.

### 4. EVALUATION AND TESTING SYSTEM

The first initial stage level, the Pre-K and Kindergarten courses, have no final exams. However, your kid will be constantly evaluated to ensure the understanding of all topics being taught in class. An example of the evaluated question could be as follows.

Instructor: what is this?Student: It's a ball.

If the answers are in full sentences, then the evaluation has succeeded.

Parents of all students will receive a "Student Performance Card" at the end of every regular unit or every 4 weeks for those taking the weekend program or intensive program.

For the other levels/programs, there is an evaluation provided to the student.

From the first day, students are evaluated to ensure their understanding of the topics that are being taught during class, and besides the practice and daily evaluation, students need to take a final unit test to continue to the next level.

## **Understanding scoring at Vin-Ter Language School**

The following chart shows a breakdown of the scoring and its meaning. This system will be used when evaluating the performance of students in three aspects of the language scoring system (LISTENING, WRITING, AND SPEAKING).



Scores awarded to students	In Letters	Meaning
8 – 10	А	Excellent Performance
5 – 7	В	Good Performance
1 – 4	С	In developing to satisfactory performance
0	D	Absent

It is required that students get a minimum of 25 points out of 30 points to be able to continue to the next level, if that student does not meet the minimum points required, students must re-take the unit. A student who has successfully completed the program will automatically be given a Vin Ter certification and could also take the international test to accredit his/her level.

### 5. LANGUAGE KNOWLEDGE ASSESSMENT TEST

The assessment test will be provided for those with an understanding of the target language and will be placed on the right language level after evaluation.

This Language Knowledge Assessment Test is divided into two parts:

- 1. Part one (Reading and Writing)
- 2. Part two (Listening and Speaking)

For those students who have stopped taking classes for over three months, they will be required to take the Language Knowledge Assessment Test to continue with the process of enrolling into classes. For those seeking to take the test, please visit our website at

### 6. ATTENDANCE

At Vin-Ter Language School, we promote the value of time for your kid and our instructors.

- 1. For the "Regular Program", a maximum of three absences is allowed, for more than three absences, the student will automatically fail the unit.
- 2. For the "Weekend Program", a maximum of one absence is allowed, for more than one absence, the student will automatically fail the unit.
- 3. For the "Intensive Program," a maximum of two absences is allowed. For more than two absences, the student will automatically fail the unit.

### 7. INTERNATIONAL TESTING

Students who have started the level program from the beginning to the end of the level program will be exempt from paying for the International Test fee<sup>1</sup>. For any information on what type of examination

### 11. GENERAL INFORMATION

### When entering and exiting the facilities:

Students must present their Vin-Ter Learner's Identification Card (Vin-ID) to enter any Vin-Ter Centers. If an ID has not been provided by the admission office yet, proof of your kid's current tuition payment will facilitate the student's entry. Otherwise, Vin-Ter security may deny entering the center.

Entry is prohibited with weapons and any object that threatens the integrity of our students or staff members.

Students must remain within our facilities only during class hours.

It is the responsibility of any parents or guardians to pick them up punctually at the end of their sessions.

Vin-Ter Language School does not have a nursery area; therefore, our Institution is not responsible for the care of students outside of academic hours.

If, for any reason, the student must leave the center before the end of a class, you must authorize and notify it personally to the front desk.
